

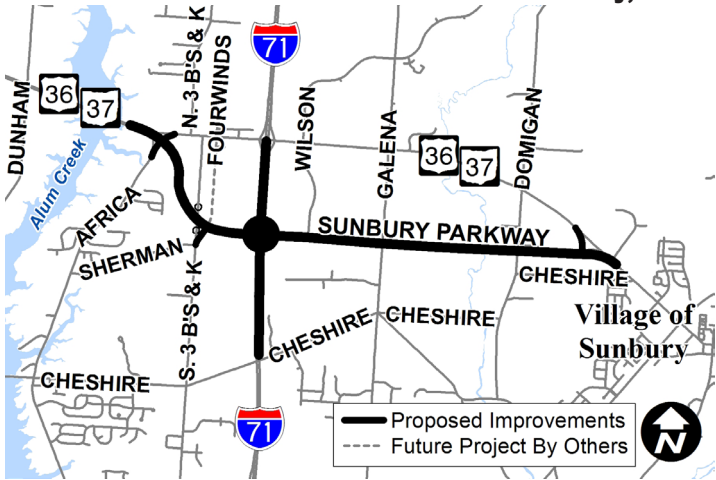


PUBLIC HEARING

The public is invited to attend a public hearing concerning the I-71 interchange improvements being considered just south of US 36/SR 37 and the proposed Sunbury Parkway.

This is a formal public hearing to review and comment on the project's Environmental Assessment (EA). An EA report has been prepared for this project and was prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). This document outlines the social, economic, and environmental impacts associated with this project and identifies the Preferred Alternative. The hearing will include a brief presentation at 5:30 p.m. The comment portion begins at 6:00 p.m. In order to comment at this hearing, you must register when you arrive at the sign-in table. Written comments may be completed at the hearing or submitted before August 11, 2017.
