Purpose of this Program

The Delaware County Special Needs Registry (DCSNR) was developed to assist local first responders and emergency managers in their efforts to appropriately plan for and respond to the needs of individuals and facilities requiring special assistance in an emergency or in the event of a disaster.

The Delaware County Special Needs Program was developed to assist the following types of individuals:

- ✓ Anyone requiring special medical assistance.
- ✓ Anyone requiring life sustaining equipment.
- ✓ Any non-ambulatory person, requiring assistance with mobility due to illness or injury, who is unable to evacuate his/her residence in the event of an emergency.
- ✓ Individuals who have cognitive or mental health impairment.
- ✓ Individuals who have vision, hearing, speech impairment, including those who have limited English proficiency.
- ✓ Anyone requiring enhanced care and assistance with daily living activities.
